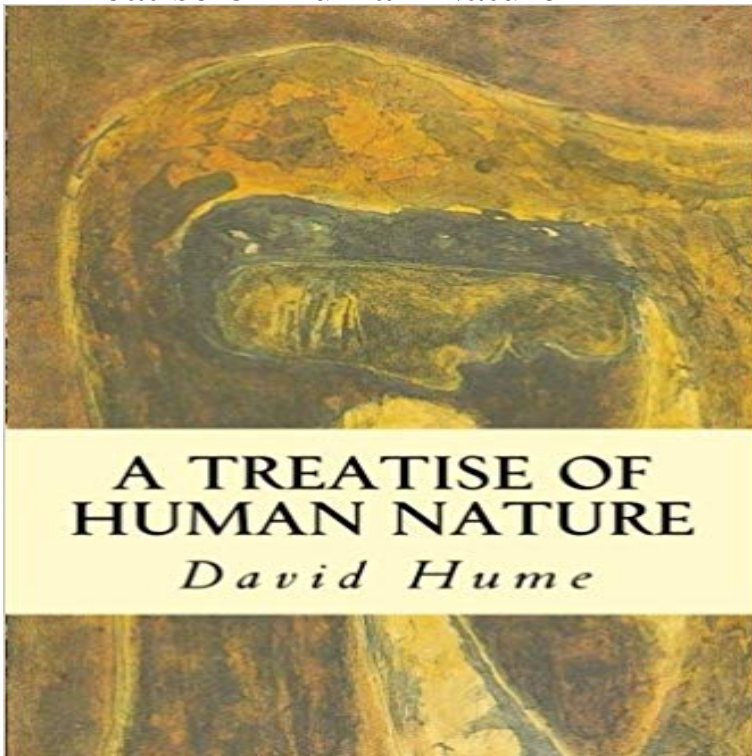


## A Treatise of Human Nature
