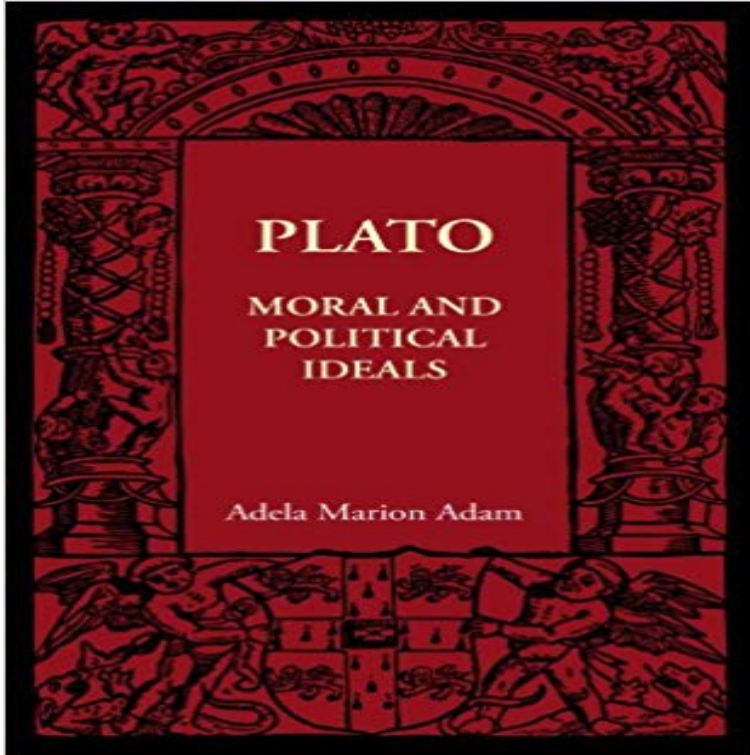


Plato: Moral and Political Ideals (Cambridge Manuals of Science and Literature)

Plato: Moral and Political Ideals by Adela Marion Adam, first printed in 1913, deals with the main substance of Platos philosophy of ethics and politics, set within the context of his intellectual debt to Socrates.
