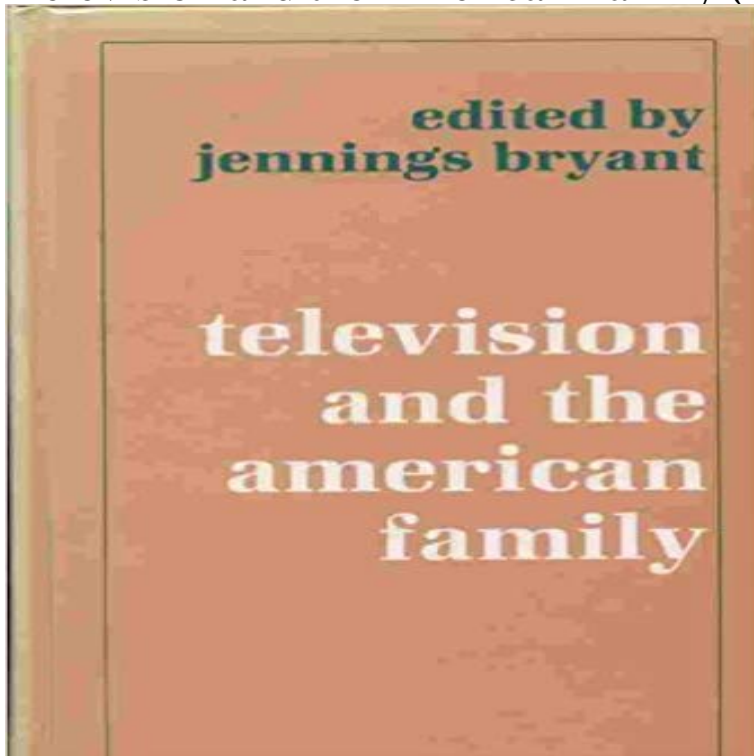


Television and the American Family (Communication Series)
