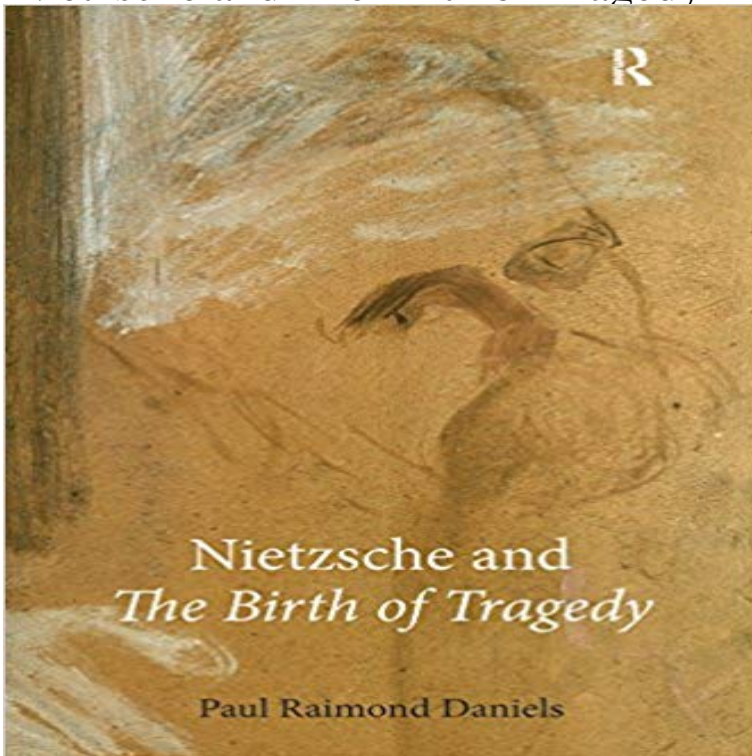


Nietzsche and The Birth of Tragedy
