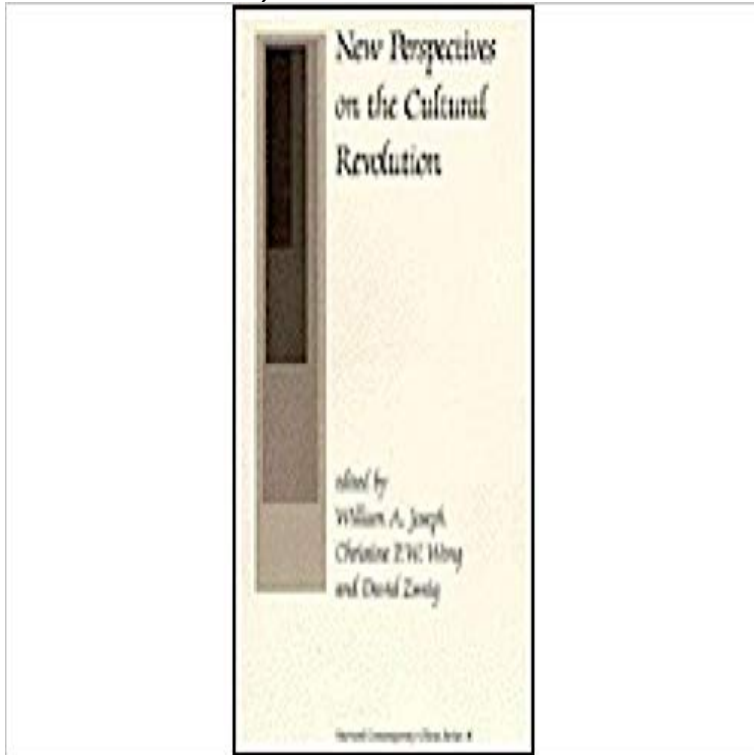


New Perspectives on the Cultural Revolution (Harvard Contemporary China Series)
